We are proud to launch the application process for our **2025–2026 Prefect Team** and **Junior Leadership Team (JLT)** — key opportunities for students to grow in confidence, responsibility, and leadership.

What Are the Roles?

Prefect

Prefects are ambassadors of our school values — Ready, Respectful and Resilient. They support the daily running of school life, assist with key events, act as role models for younger students, and take pride in representing Tenbury High both in and out of lessons.

Junior Leadership Team (JLT)

Our most senior student leaders, JLT members take on additional responsibilities and lead projects that directly improve school life. They apply for specific strands such as:

- Enrichment & Wellbeing
- Community & Charity
- Academic Support & Leadership
- Environment & Culture
- House Leadership

JLT members will present a project idea to staff, attend an interview, and work closely with school leaders throughout the year.

How Do Students Apply?

All Year 10 students are invited to apply by completing a leadership application form. Students can apply to be a **Prefect**, a **JLT member**, or both. The application includes a short-written statement and the option to outline a project idea if applying for JLT.

Shortlisted JLT candidates will be invited for an interview and will present their ideas to staff.

Forms and guidance will be shared with students during tutor time and are also available from Mrs Dean or Mrs Prouse.
