### Year 11 Pupils' and Parents' Evening – Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> March 2026

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Firstly, I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your support during the recent mock examination period. Our examinations team have been extremely impressed with the pupils' attitudes and with how hard they have been working throughout their exams. The next time pupils sit in the sports hall for an examination will be during the final summer series. There is not much time left before the examination window begins, and there is still a great deal of important work to complete.

With this in mind, I would like to invite you and your son/daughter to a face-to-face Year 11 Parents' Evening. This will provide an opportunity to discuss the most recent mock examination results, identify priorities, and ensure pupils are fully supported during these final crucial months leading up to the summer exams. Please note that the results of the recent mock exams will be shared on Arbor at 2.00 pm on 26<sup>th</sup> March.

Following some parent feedback, we have reflected on how we run our parents' evenings. We recognise that the usual booking system can be stressful; appointments quickly go and parents can be left feeling that they have not met with the teachers they want to meet with. Likewise, the structure of the evening itself can be noisy, appointments lacking privacy with appointment schedules falling by the wayside quickly. None of this is conducive to building positive home school relationships and understanding how both school and home can work specifically together for the success of your child.

Therefore, we made some changes and our recent Year 10 parents' evening ran very well and we are confident the new model will work with Year 11 too. You will not be required to book individual teacher appointments – we are doing away with appointments. Alternatively, you will book in to one of two sessions which will determine the time slot you can arrive in school. The later you arrive in your time slot, the less likely you will be able to meet with all of your child's teachers. The time slots are stated below.

- **Session 1: 4:00–5:30 pm**
- **Session 2: 5:30–7:00 pm**

There will be up to 7 teachers to see in this time: English, Maths, Science, 4 option teachers, plus Mrs Bradbury (SENCO) where appropriate. There will not be an option to meet with non-examined subjects ie core RPE, Core PE and PD. Appointments will last no more than five minutes and we have strongly encouraged staff to stick to these timings to ensure the evening runs to plan.

The event will be spread out using other areas of the school, rather than solely in the main hall. This will improve the noise and stop overcrowding. You choose who you see and in what order. Where there is a parent already with a teacher you wish to see, we will provide seating to enable you to wait for a short amount of time until the teacher is free. There will be some waiting/queuing time, but this has to be expected.

Tea, coffee and refreshments will be provided.



I really hope you can attend and the changes to the evening make for an enjoyable visit to THOA. Your child's success benefits from open communication between school and home and this is a perfect opportunity to communicate.
