Subject: Year 10 Prom Tracking

Dear Parents/Carers

As we begin preparing our Year 10 pupils for their final year, we would like to inform you about our Prom eligibility tracking system, which will be introduced as a *mock process* during this half term.

This trial period is designed to help pupils understand the expectations required in Year 11 and to give them every opportunity to meet the criteria ahead of time.

During this half term, we will be monitoring the following:

- Attendance
- Lates to school/lessons
- Truancy (missing lessons without permission)
- Homework detentions
- Behaviour points
- House points

This monitoring period is designed to support pupils and help get them ready for the Prom eligibility criteria, which will begin in September of Year 11. These guidelines have been in place for several years to help pupils stay focused, motivated, and achieve their best in their final year so they can finish strong and enjoy Prom as a celebration of all their hard work.

To be eligible to attend Prom, pupils must meet the following standards:

- Maintain **attendance of at least 93%**
- Have **no more than 5 lates per half term**
- **Not truant** from any lessons
- Receive **no more than 5 homework detentions per half term**
- Accrue **no more than 10 behaviour points per half term**

All pupils must also be 'debt' free on transport and catering accounts before leavers' day in June 2027.

Please note that failure to meet these criteria in Year 11 is likely to result in pupils *not being permitted to attend Prom*.



If a pupil does not meet the criteria during this half-term 'mock' period, they will be placed on a **Prom Report** at the start of Year 11. This is a supportive measure intended to help them improve and ensure they begin their final year with the best possible chance of success.

We encourage you to discuss these expectations with your child and support them in developing the positive habits needed to meet these standards.
