Dear Parents/Carers

Condoover Hall Residential Trip Wednesday 14th July to Friday 16th July 2027

We are excited to announce that we are organising a residential trip to JCA Condoover Hall near Shrewsbury. This trip will be 3 days and 2 nights and takes place from Wednesday 14th July to Friday 16th July 2027. This trip is available to ALL pupils although we have provisionally booked enough places for 60 pupils. This can be increased but we must confirm numbers with JCA in October and it will be difficult to alter the booking after this date. Further details regarding the trip will be provided at the Year 7 Parents' Information Evening on Tuesday 13th October (a letter will be sent out about this meeting separately).

Trip details:

The centre offers abseiling, climbing, canoeing, kayaking, high ropes, archery, fencing as well as many other activities. The centre is in a grade 1 listed Elizabethan mansion built in the 16th century and set in 78 acres. We will stay in a purpose-built accommodation block for two nights with one full day of activities and two half days of instruction. The meals are excellent and provided in a purpose-built cafeteria. The cost for this trip will be £370 and this includes coach transport, accommodation, activity instruction and insurance. At the end of this letter is a payment plan, this will give you an outline of due dates and amounts.

If you would like to book a place on the trip, we are asking for a non-refundable deposit of £50.00 to be paid on ParentPay by Friday 25th September to secure a place for your child. The deposit will be available as a payment on ParentPay until the 60 spaces have been taken. If you would like your son/daughter to attend, we will have a reserve list and look to increase numbers if there is interest.

If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium and you would like to request using part of the allowance for the trip, please email the finance office on finance@tenburyhigh.co.uk. Pupils can use £50 towards a trip, any extra left at the end of the academic year can be applied as well. **Any funding will be applied to the final instalment only.**

Positive school attendance and excellent behaviour are really important for all pupils and will always be a consideration for any pupil attending a school trip. Any pupil taking an unauthorised holiday during the school year, will not be allowed on the trip. Pupils are expected to uphold our values, showing kindness, respect and hard work at all times. Should pupils, allocated a place on the trip, demonstrate persistently negative behaviours such as repeated C3 or C4's, parents will be invited in to school to discuss their child's behaviour. A pupil's place on the trip will be in jeopardy if progress is not made. If a pupil is removed from the trip, a refund will not be possible if the place does not get filled by a reserve place. **Please note there will be a behaviour agreement and a mobile phone agreement to sign for pupils going on the trip.**

For this residential trip, mobile phones **will** be allowed. However, pupils will be expected to hand their phones to teaching staff every day before bedtime and these will be returned at breakfast time. The phones will not be charged during the night, so pupils will need to find alternative times during the day to charge their phones. If, at any point, a pupil is using their mobile phone inappropriately or in a way that puts another child at risk, there will be a zero-tolerance approach and the phone will be confiscated for a period of time determined by the lead teacher.
